



Indian Cove Campsite Info -

You can get a camp site map here at the Ranger Check in !!

Stop and check the bulletin board or door pocket at the Ranger Station for "who's in what site" info - also this is THE ONLY WATER fill up at Indian Cove, so tank up on your way in . . .

If you are in a Group site (#1 thru #13) look for a "Group Site" sign about 1/2 mi past the ranger and then turn right.

If you are in a Family site (#1 thru #89) keep going straight, the road will fork - low # sites are to the left and higher #'s are to the right

GETTING THERE

Joshua Tree National Park lies 140 miles East of Los Angeles. You can approach it from the West via Interstate 10 passing through Banning and White Water and then taking Highway 62 (Twenty Nine Palms Highway) to the North entrances of the park which are located in the towns of Joshua Tree and Twenty Nine Palms.

The entrance to Indian Cove is in the town of Twenty Nine Palms, approximately 15 miles from the 247 FRWY in Yucca Valley and 10 miles from the town of Joshua Tree. Some land marks to watch for as you travel through Joshua Tree going East, will be a hospital and the Highway Patrol facility on the right.

On the left hand side look for the Copper Mountain Campus, and lastly the radio tower (which you may not see if traveling at night) that puts you 1 mile from the entrance to Indian Cove. Turn right at Indian Cove Road, and follow it to the _____ campground. Pets are not allowed on trails and are restricted to developed areas only.

After turning off of Highway 62 head straight South, past a few homes and into the Park

You will know you are there when you arrive at the Indian Cove Ranger Station check-in.
